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Management of Pittaj Mutrakruchhra (Urinary Tract Infection) with Vidariyadi Vati (Pueraria tuberosa Linn, Tribulus terrestris Linn, Glycyrrhiza glabra Linn, Mesua ferrea Linn, Magnatite) - A Single Case Report

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ABSTRACT

Urinary tract infections (UTIs) are very common and can be detrimental to health and quality of life. The overall prevalence of UTI was 33.54% of which 66.78% were females and scan be corelated to *Mutrakruchhra. Vidaradi Vati* having drugs *Vidari Churna (Pureraria Tuberosa Linn), Gokshur Churn (*Tribulus terrestris Linn), *Madhuyashti Churn* (Glycyrrhiza glabra Linn), *Nagkeshar Churn* (Mesua ferrea Linn), *Loha Bhasm (Magnatite)*. Combinations of these all *Churn* create a good effect and are effective in reliving symptoms of *Mutrakruchhra* (Urinary Tract Infection). When there is recurrence of Urinary Tract Infection and patient is frustrated by taking allopathy medicine, there is need to find new medication which will give complete relief to patient. Patient has already invested so much of money for treatment there is need to find new cost effective treatment. As manifestation of *Mutrakrucchra* and urinary tract infection are similar, an attempt has been made in this article to understand the concept of urinary tract infection and to make formulation effective on *Mutrakruchhra* (Urinary Tract Infection).

INTRODUCTION

Health as well as quality of life of individuals is affected due most common disease *Mutrakruchhra*. *Mutrakruchhra* can be correlated to Urinary Tract Infection. The overall prevalence of UTI was 33.54% of

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which 66.78% were females and 33.22% were from males. High prevalence 2:1 was observed in females as compared to males. During whole life 50-80% of women have Urinary Tract Infection at least once. Globally more than 150 Million people are affected annually.

Acharya Charak and Acharya Sushrut have described about Mutrakruchhra, it's classification, symptoms and treatment. There are 8 types of Mutrakruccha and Pittaj Mutrakruchhra is one of them. The Lakshanas of Pittaja Mutra Kruchha (Urinary Tract Infection) like Peet Mutrapravruti means yellowish discoloration of urine, Sadaha Mutrapravruti means burning sensation during maturation, Sashul means painful maturation & Muhur Muhur Mutrapravruti means with increased frequency. Sarkta Mutrapravruti means heamaturia All these signs and symptoms can be correlated to Urinary Tract Infection of modern science. Il Infection

in Urinary Tract leads to arrange of symptoms and signs that reflect the location and severity of the infection. [9] Poor hygienic conditions and environment, poverty and illiteracy also contribute to the increasing percentage of Urinary tract Infection. The studies have shown that one in 5 adult women experience a UTI at some point, confirming that it is an exceedingly common worldwide problem.[3] E.coli is by far the commonest cause of uncomplicated communityacquired UTIs in both outpatient and inpatient settings. common uropathogen other Other common uropathogens are Enterococcus faecalis, Enterobacter species. Staphylococc saprophyticus, Klebsiella pneumoniae, Proteus mirabilis and pseudomonas species.[2]

NEED OF STUDY

Pittaj Mutrakruchhra (Urinary Tract Infection) has lots of physical concern in day-to-day life of people. In modern science UTI is treated but the effect is temporary & patients come with recurrence for most of the time.

In Ayurveda *Pittaj Mutrakruchhra* (Urinary Tract Infection) can be treated effectively by using herbal medicines. ^[1,3] Modern treatment of UTI comprises of antibiotics, antispasmodics, alkalisers which have their own side effects and limitations. We have many *Yogas* formulation in Ayurvedic classics which are giving having good result, cost effective, can be taken by patient on OPD basis. There is need to find more effective medicine as an option to other market preparation *Vallipanchmul Kwath*, Syrup Ural.

There is need to find more effective, side effect free and economical treatment on *Pittaj Mutrakruchha* (Urinary Tract Infection).

Thus, *Vidaradi Vati* will be use on *Pittaj Mutrakruchha* (Urinary Tract Infection)

CASE REPORT

A 38 years old female came to OPD of Dr. D Y Patil College of Ayurveda and Research Center resident of Pune, Maharashtra. She was having *Peet Mutrapravrutti* (yellowish discolouration of urine),

Sadaha Mutrapravrutti (burning sensation during micturition), Sashul Mutrapravrutti (pain during/after micturition), Muhur Muhur Mutrapravrutti at night (increased frequency of micturition at night) i.e., 7 times Micturition at night.

Patient was suffering from above symptoms since 2 year intermittently i.e., once in three months in past she has taken many therapies but there was recurrence of disease.

Neither history of major illness nor any past surgical history.



Investigations

Urine (Routine/Microscopic) - Randomly freshly voided sample is usually adequate for most tests.^[10]

Preparation of Vidaryadi Vati

Vidarikand Churna (Pueraria tuberosa Linn), Gokshur Churna (Tribulus terrestris Linn), Madhuyashti Churna (Glycyrrhiza glabra Linn), Nagkeshar Churna (Mesua ferrea Linn), Loha Bhasma (Magnatite) all are taken in Saam Pramana i.e., 50mg each Churna and Vati is made of 250mg.

Chikitsa

Vidaryadi Vati

For first 5 days - 250 mg - QID (4 times a day) with water

For day 6 to day 8 - 250mg - TDS (Three times a day) with water

For day 9 to 12 - 250mg BD - (Two times a day) with water

Importance of Drugs

Vidaryadi Churna (Pueraria tuberosa Linn) - It is used in Mutrakruchhra, Daha, Daurblya. It can be used as diuretic. It is used as carminative, nutritive, cardiotonic. It can be used in Yakrit Roga.

Rasa, Vipak - Madhur; Veerya - Sheeta. Due to Madhur Rasa and Sheet Veerya, Vidari subsides Pitta Dosha predominantly. The drug is having Gamitva (affinity) towards Mootravaha Srotas. Vidari acts as potential drug to subside excess / vitiated / Prakupita Pitta Dosha within Mootravaha Srotas. Thus, Vidari can be enlisted as drug of choice to relive Pittaja Mutrakruchha.

Gukshur Churna (Tribulus terrestris Linn) - An infusion of fresh leaves and stem is used as an esteemed remedy for treating dysuria i.e., painful urination. The decoction is useful in irritation of urinary organs, it is given as remedy for incontinence of urine. Fruit powder is used in kidney and urinary troubles.^[13]

Rasa, Vipak - Madhur; Veerya - Sheeta. Due to Madhur Rasa, Gokshur subsides Pitta and Vata Dosha predominantly. This is the drug of choice in any pathological condition of Mutravaha Strotas. Gokshur acts as potential drug to subside excess / vitiated / Prakupita Pitta Dosha within Mutravaha Strotas. Thus, Gokshur can be enlisted as drug of choice to relive Pittaja Mutrakruchhra.

Madhuyashti Churna (Glycyrrhiza glabra Linn) - The drug is used as laxative, diuretic, anticolic and herbal antacid. It is useful in dysuria. It is Rasayan (health

promotive), *Jivaniya* (life promotive and rajuvenative), *Balya* (body strengthened).

Rasa, Vipak - Madhur; Veerya - Sheeta. Due to Madhur Rasa, Yashti subsides Pitta and Vata Dosha predominantly. This drug is enlisted under "Rasayan" category as the drug is having potential to rejuvenate and strengthen body cells. Yashtimadhu subsides excess Pitta in Mutravaha Strotas and strengthen urinary tract cells.^[5]

Nagkeshar Churna (Mesua ferrea Linn) - The drug Nagkeshar is useful in several diseases and it is specifically valued as Amapachna. It can be used in Mutrakruchhra, Mutradaha and in Mutramargat Raktapitta.

Nagkeshar having Rasa - Kashay Tikta, Vipak - Ushna, Veerya - Katu due to this it is the potential drug to relieve any kind of bleeding from urethra, vagina and anus. This characteristic prove that the drug is good to treat excess Pitta / Raktadhatu get excess Pitta. This is the potential drug to vitiated Pitta in Mutravaha Strotas.^[7]

Loha Bhasma (Magnetite) - Loha Bhasm is Rasayana,^[14] thus very good quality of Rasadi Dhatu are formed which in turn causes all Indriyas to be perform in good way. All the Dhatu gets all the ingredient in proper quantity thus healthy body is obtain. When there is no relief by using much treatment we should use Loha Bhasma. When we use Loha Bhasm in Mutrakruchhra we get relief.^[8]

Apathya

Mutrakruccha patients should avoid exercise, suppression of natural urges, oily food, Kapittha, Jambu, riding elephants or horses. The patient should also avoid taking incompatible meals, excessive or very less amount of food, betel nuts, fishes, Kalka of sesame seeds, sesame oil, mustard oil, Masa or foods prepared from it, hot, unctuous and citrus edible. While taking Loha Bhasm things to be avoided are Kushmanda, sesame oil, Rajika, Rasona (garlic), Madya (liquor), Amla Rasa.




Microscopic observation of urine slides


Microscopic observation of urine slide

Result By using Assessment and Objective criteria:

- 1. Complete Relief About more than 75% complete disappearance of known symptoms.
- 2. Marked relief About 50 % to 75% disappearance of known symptoms and absence of complications.
- 3. Moderate relief About 50 % reliefs in symptoms
- 4. Mild relief 25 % relief in symptoms.
- 5. No relief No relief in symptoms.

RESULT

From Assessment criteria we get grade-0 and from Objective Criteria we get grade-0. Thus, from both criteria patient get about more than 75% complete disappearance of known symptoms i.e., She got complete relief.

DISCUSSION

Vidari Kanda Churn (Pueraria tuberosa Linn) is Madhurras and Madhur Vipak due to which it is Vatapittasamak. Vidari is Mutral, Dahaprashman, Balya, Bruhana, Rasayana.^[6]

Goshur Churna (Tribulus terrestris Linn) causes Dipan of Jatharagni and Bhautikaagni. Goshur (Tribulus terrestris Linn) cause Pachan of Aama created by Pruthavi and Jalmahabhutadhikya thus in turn decreased in symptoms of Mutrakruchha (Urinary Tract Infection). We get relief from Mutradushti. [13] Prabhay of Goshur is Mutral.

Madhuyashti (Glycyrrhiza glabra Linn) is Mutravirajniya, whatever Vaivarnya (Discoloration of Urine) caused due to Pitta Prakop is destroyed by Madhuyashti. Thus, normal color to urine is obtain by using Madhuyashti, due to Vatapittashamak pain and burning sensation is relieved in Mutrakruchhra. [5]

Nagkeshar (Mesua ferrea Linn) consist of Tikta Ras which causes Dipan Pachan of Ama. Thus aggravated Pitta in Mutramarg may cause shaman which in turn causes destruction of Paka Lakshan in Mutravah Strotas. Due to Mutral Karya painful maturation can be relieved.^[7]

Loha Bhasma (Magnatite) - Loha is Rasayana, thus very good quality of Rasadi Dhatu are formed which in turn causes all Indriyas to be perform in good way. All the Dhatu gets all the ingredient in proper quantity carried by Rakta Dhatu thus healthy body is obtain.^[14]

Vidari Kand Churn acts as Dahaprashmana, Goshur Churna act as Mutral, Madhuyashti is Mutravirjaniya, Nagkeshar is Mutral and does Dipan Pachan of Ama, Loha Bhasm is Rasayan collectively they contribute to form Vidaryadi Vati. All drugs used in Vidaryadi Vati Act as Vatpittashamak and helps to distruct the Samprapti of Mutrakruchha. Combining all ingredients Vidari, Madhuyashti, Gokshur, Nagkeshar are Vatpittashamak gives relief from Sadah Mutrapravrutti, Sashul Mutrapravrutti, Muhur Muhur Mutra Pravrutti. Loha Bhasm acts as Rasayan to make healthy and strong body.

CONCLUSION

Vidaryadi Vati is effective in reducing the symptoms of Pittaj Mutrakruchhra in patient and she got good relief. Thus, Vidariyadi Vati is effective in Pittaj Mutrakruchhra

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
