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Lepa Kalpana - A Review

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ABSTRACT

Ayurveda the science of life is the most ancient medical knowledge in the world. Metals and minerals are in frequent use in Indian system of medicine since long back without any untowards effect. In *Bhaishjya Kalpana* application of herbal drug externally known as *Lepa*. *Lepa* preparation are the topical medicaments meant for external application to the skin or mucosal membrane. The topical preparation include *Lepa*, *Upanaha*, *Malhara* etc. out of many *Bahya Kalpana*, *Lepa Kalpana* has due importance in Ayurvedic system of medicine. *Lepa Kalpana* are used in different conditions like inflammation, wound healing, wound cleaning and many more uses.

INTRODUCTION

Lepa Kalpana is the herbal preparation used for external use. In Ayurveda Lepa Kalpana is mainly described in Sharangdhar Samhita, Sushrut Samhita and Vaghbhat Samhita. The main basic concept of Lepa is that, wet drugs are pounded to fine paste form and the dry drugs are pounded to fine powder form and mixed with any of the liquid media like Swarasa, Kwatha, Ghrita, Taila, Godugdha, Gomutra, Jala etc. according to demands of particular disease condition or need. This paste is used for application as Lepa. This Lepa Kalpana is used for externally according to different disease condition. Lepa Kalpana plays an important role in treating different disease conditions.

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MATERIALS AND METHODS

In *Lepa Kalpana* different herbal drug in the form of powder is taken and is triturated with different media to form paste and applied externally as *Lepa*. Materials are different for different disease condition.

Types of Lepa

According to Acharya Sushruta three types of Lepa,^[1]

- 1. Pralepa
- 2. Pradeha
- 3. Alepa.

According to *Acharya Sharangdhar* three types of *Lepa*.^[2]

- 1. Doshgna
- 2. Vishgna
- 3. Varnya

According to Acharya Vaghbhat ten types of Lepa.^[3]

- 1. Snaihika
- 2. Nirvapana
- 3. Prasadana
- 4. Stambhana
- 5. Vilayana

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- 6. Pachana
- 7. Pidana
- 8. Shodhana
- 9. Shoshana
- 10. Savarnikaran
- Pralepa Lepa: It is cold and thin in nature. This Lepa is prepared from Sheeta Virya Dravyas.
- Pradeha Lepa: It is cold or hot in nature. It is used in mainly Vata Kaphaja disease conditions.
- Alepa Lepa: This Lepa fall in between above two Lepa. It is neither applied too thin or too thick.

Thickness of Lepa

Acharya Sushruta has compared thickness of Lepa to skin of Buffaloes. Also Acharya Sharangdhar opinion is same about thickness of Lepa. Other commentator opinion is different. They say for Doshghna Lepa - 1/4 Angula, Vishaghna Lepa -1/3 Angula and in Varnya Lepa - 1/2 Angula thickness is to be applied.

Quantity of Sneha in Lepa

In *Lepa* preparation certain amount of *Sneha* i.e. *Ghrita, Taila* is to be mixed in proper quantity is necessary. So *Acharya Sushruta* said about their proportion. In *Vata Vyadhi* - 1/4 part, in *Pittaja Vyadhi* - 1/3 part and in *Kaphaja Vyadhi* - 1/2 part of *Sneha* is to be added in *Lepa* preparation.

Uses of Lepa

Lepa are used in different disease condition and predominance of *Dosha*. *Lepa* are used for wound healing, wound cleaning, faireness of skin and many more uses.

Conditions for Lepa preparation and Application

- Ingredients are taken in fine powder form.
- Lepa are applied against hair follicle direction to facillate quicker and good absorption.

- Lepa are to be removed instantly after drying.
- *Lepa* should not be applied during night.

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• Overlapping of *Lepa* is avoided strictly.

DISCUSSION

Lepa are the topical medicament meant for external application. Herbal drugs are taken as said by text and triturated with media and applied on skin is the basic concept of *Lepa*. Different references of *Lepa* is said in text as per their disease condition and their *Dosha* predominance. For better result in disease condition thickness, quantity of *Sneha* and certain condition for *Lepa* preparation and application is to be followed strictly.

CONCLUSION

Lepa are the key medicine for external application on skin. *Lepa* are used in different disease condition like wound cleaning, wound healing, faireness of skin, inflammation, acne and many more disease condition. In this way we can say that *Lepa* plays an important role in Ayurved system of medicine.

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
