# The Harita Samhita - A Literary Review on an ancient Ayurvedic text

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# ABSTRACT

Harita Samhita is one of the classical work on Ayurvedic medicine, which is written in between 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> century AD. This book is written in conversation module, and the conversation was between Maharshi Atreya and Acharya Harita. Acharya Harita has proposed his own new concepts in his texts. The present text is divided into six parts, viz; Prathamasthana, Dwitiyasthana, Chikitsasthana, Sutrasthana, Kalpasthana, Sharirasthana. The Harita Samhita can be included under Dravyaguna Shastra. In present work the concepts of Acharya Harita were critically analyzed and elaborated systematically. Further scope of study is to critically analyze the work of Acharya Harita and explore his views to the Ayurvedic scholars.

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Acharya Harita was the one of the disciple of Maharshi Atreya, who was renowned person in the history of Ayurveda. Acharya Harita had written his own text named as Harita Samhita. Harita Samhita is the conversation between the Maharshi Atreya and Acharya Harita. The Harita Samhita text is divided into six parts, viz; Pratahamasthana, Dwitiyasthana, Chikitsasthana, Sutrasthana, Kalpasthana, Sharirasthana. As the author was the devotee of Lord Shiva so the text starts with Mangalacharana, in the name of Lord Shiva and the discussion goes on which

is elaborated in the discussion part.

#### Pratahama Sthana<sup>[1]</sup>

The Harita Samhita starts with Mangalacharana praising Lord Shiva.

- The first chapter named as Pathana Vidhi Adhyaya, deals with the conversation between Maharshi Atreya and Acharya Harita about the importance of Ayurveda, its branches and how this Shatra has to be studied.
- Ayurveda Adhyayana Adhikari Explains who has to study the Ayurveda.
- Pooja Yogya Vaidya Lakshanas Dharmistha, Shanta, Pavitra, Shuddha Buddhi, Dhairya Sheela, Kushala, etc. qualities.
- Vaidya Swaroopa The Vaidya whose diagnose should be perfect. He must be able to eradicate the diseases of the Rogi.
- Tyajya Vaidya Lakshana The one who is Lobhi, Krodhi, Kathora, Madyapaayi, Alasi, Dharyaheena, Asthira Chitta, Dhanaheena etc., such Vaidya should be avoided for the treatment.

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- Vaidya Shastra Pathana Vidhi One should avoid Pathana by Uccha Bhashana, slow voice, trembling etc.
- Anadhyaya One should not study the Shastra on the occasion of Pratipada, Asthamai, Chaturdashi, Amavasya, Purnima, Akala, Durdina, Ghanagarjana, Digdaha, Bhuchala, Soorya and Chandra Grahana. If one should study in these conditions will suffer from Gurupeeda, Rajapeeda, Rashtra Peeda, Marana etc.

# The 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter named *Chikitsa Sangraha* deals with eight types of treatments.

- The first part deals with Annapana Sthana, Aristha Sthana, Chikitsa Sthana, Kalpa Sthana, Sutra Sthana, Sharira Sthana.
- Shalya, Shalakya, Kaya Chikitsa, Bala Chikitsa, Agada - Visha Tantra, Bhuta Vidya, Rasayana and Vajikarana.
- Yantra Karma, Shastra Karma, Agni Karma, Aushadha, Swedana, Mardana, these are the subtypes of Chikitsa.
- Shalya Tantra The Shastra which deals to remove the Shalya like arrow, Bhala, Trina, Panshu, Krimi, Puya, etc. from the body.
- Shalakya Tantra The branch which deals with Shira, Netra, Karna, Brukuti, Kantha, Shankha, Manya etc. are known as Shalakya Tantra.
- Kaya Chikitsa Which deals with Kwatha, Churna, Gutika, Snehana, Swedana, Vamana, Virechana, Basthi etc. these all alleviates the Kosthagata Doshas and maintains the health.
- Agada Nama The one which cures the Guda and Basthigata Rogas. The Niruha Basthi, Asthapana Basthi, and Anuvasana Basthi comes under Agada Tantra. This is the peculiarity of this book.
- Bala Chikitsa In this Garbha Upakrama, Sutika Upakrama and Bala Roga Shamaka medicines are dealt.
- Visha Tantra In this branch all the poisonous Krimis, Vrischika, Sarpa etc. are dealt with.

- Bhuta Vidya Griha, Bhuta, Pishacha, Shakuni, Dakini and Sooryadi Griha their effects on the body are dealt.
- Vajikarana In this the person who become very lean and suffering from aspermia or erectile dysfunction and Dhatu Kshinata etc. treatments are dealt.
- Rasayana To achieve health of the healthy person like Indiya Balakara, Dridhikara, Palitya, Khalitya etc. are dealt.
- Upanga Chikitsa Chinna, Bhinna, Bhagna, Kshata, Picchita and Dagdha Vrana treatment is dealt in this section.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> chapter named *Vaidya Shiksha Vidhanam* - This explains about the teaching module of the Ayurveda *Vaidya Shastra*.

- The first section deals with eligibility for treatment, then one should have the knowledge of Desha, Kala, Vya, Jatharagni, Aushadha, Prakruti Samyata, Sharira, Mana, Bala, Vyadhi Avastha.
- Chikista Phalashruti, Vaidya's eligibility criteria, Types of Vaidya, Types of treatment (Shamana and Kopana), Vyadhi Sadhyasadhyata, Upacahara Phalashruti, complications of Doshas which are inherent after treatment, Apathya Haani etc.
- Langhana Yogya, Jatharagni Karma, Sama Nirama Lakshana, Punyartha Upachara Yogya Manushya, Achievement during treatment, Chikista Ayogya Purusha and lastly the duties of the Vaidya are explained.

The 4<sup>th</sup> chapter named *Desha-Kala-Balabalam* - This chapter explains about the different climatic conditions viz;

- Types of Desha Anupa Desha, Jangala Desha, Sadharana Desha.
- Kala Jnana Kala Swaroopa, Utpadaka Kala, Kala Pravartaka, Kala Samharaka, Kala Sanatanatwa, Kala Nashaka Swaroopa etc.
- Rutucharya, Uttarayana, Dakshinayana.

Rutu sambadhi Vichara - Varsha, Sharad, Hemant, Shishira, Vasanta, Grishma.

#### The fifth chapter deals with Vaya Jnana

- Madhyama Vaya
- Prakruti Jnana Vata, Pitta, Kapha Prakruti Lakshanas.
- Vayu Bheda according to Dishas like Purva, Uttara Disha, Agneya Disha Vayu Lakshanas etc.
- Types of Vayu Tala Putra Vayu, Vyajana Vayu, Vayu Dishas according to Shad Rutu, Savisha Vayu, Vayu Prakopa lakshana, and Upashamana, Pitta Prakopa, Nidana, Kapha Prakopa Nidana, Sannipata Utpatti.

### The 6th chapter deals with Shadrasa

- Vatadi Dosha Viruddha Rasa, Dosha Virodhi Rasa Varnana.
- Shadrasa Virya Vivechna.

# The 7<sup>th</sup> chapter deals with various types of water - *Jala Varga*.

- Various types of water like Samudra Jala, Ganga Jala, Rutu Anusara Jala Varnana.
- Arogyadayaka Jala, Shitala Jala, Jala Vishayaka Vidhi etc. are dealt.

#### The 8th chapter explains Dugdha Varga

- In this section various types of animals Dugdha Vargas are explained. Like cow, goat, camel, Stree, etc.
- Properties of milk which is consumed during day time and during night time.
- Various types of *Dadhi*, its consumption according to *Rutus* and day and night.
- Various types of buttermilk consumption and its properties.
- Various types of ghee and its properties are well explained.

### The 9th chapter which deals with Mutra Varga

 In this various types of animals Mutra Vargas are explained. Like goat, cow, camel, donkey,

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Naramutra, Prasuta and Aprasuta Mutra qualities are well defined.

# The 10<sup>th</sup> chapter which deals with sugarcane called as *Ikshu Varga*.

- In this section all types of Ikshu Varga, Its juices expressed from various sources like machines, teeth, Pakwa Rasa, Phanita.
- Types of Guda, Guda Khanda, Sadharana Khanda, Sharkara and importance of Guda are enumerated.

# The 11th chapter deals with qualities Kanjika Varga.

Deals with qualities of rice water, Tushodaka, Yava and Godhuma Kanji, Taila Yukta Kanji, Yuqandhara Kanji and importance of Kanji.

# The 12<sup>th</sup> chapter deals with qualities of *Manda Varga*.

 Qualities of Rakta Shali Manda, Sheta Shali Manda, Yava Manda, Godhuma Manda, Kshudranna Manda, Kodrava Manda, Kshudra Anna Kanji Guna are explained.

# The 13th chapter deals with Yusha Varga.

 Qualities of Yusha, Kulattha Yusha, Haritaki Yusha, Mudga Yusha, Chanaka Yusha, Udada Yusha etc. Yusha Kalpanas are explained.

#### The 14th chapter deals with Taila-Vasa Varga.

- Qualities of Taila like Sarshapa Taila, Tila Taila, Eranda Taila, Kusumbha Taila, Narikela Taila etc. has been explained.
- Importance of Taila and Vasa Varga are well enumerated.

# The 15<sup>th</sup> chapter deals with various types of *Dhanya Vargas*.

• Qualities of Shali Dhanya, Shali Dhanya Guna-Dosha, Kshudra Dhanya, Shyamaka, Kodrava, Yava Godhuma, Udada, Mudga, Tuvara, Kulattha, Masura etc. cereals are explained.

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# The 16<sup>th</sup> chapter explains about different varieties of vegetables

- Vegetables like Jeevanti, Jayanti, Chillaka, Ketaki, Methika, Shatapushpa, Changeri, Kusumbha etc. are mentioned under Shaka Varga.

- In this Varga different types of fruits like Amra, Jambu, Badara, Dadima, Matulunga, Nimbuka, Chincha, Kharjura, Poogiphala, Kadali Phala, Draksha, fruits etc. are explained.
- Properties of Nagavalli, Khadirasara, Karpura with Shunthi should be consumed mixed with Churnka are enumerated.

# The 18th chapter deals with Madhu Varga.

- This chapter deals with different types of honey like Bhramara, Saradha, Kshaudra.
- Importance of Madhu and its general properties are enumerated.

#### The 19th chapter deals with alcoholic beverages.

- This Varga explains different types of Madhya and their properties.
- Sidhu Madya, Gauda, Matsyandi, Madhivka, Madira, Paishthi Madira, Mahuva Madira, Taada Madira and the importance of Madhya are well explained.

# The 20th chapter deals with Mamsa Varga.

In this Varga different types of Sarisrapa, Anupa, Jangala, Jalachara, Grmchari Pashu Varga, Pakshi Varga, Chitranga Mansa, Chikkara Mamsa, Rakta Mriga Mamsa, Shukara Mamsa, Shasha Mamsa, Mushaka Mamsa, Go Mamsa are dealt.

# The 21<sup>st</sup> chapter deals with domestic use different types of *Mamsa Varga*.
